Legal basis are § 2 and 14 of the Law on the Foundation of the Technische Informationsbibliothek $(TIB)^1$ and Art. 6 § 1 a) of the European General Data Protection Regulation².

In order to use the Research Data Repository of FID BAUdigital for data publication, the creation of a user account is required. For this purpose, the specification of a user name and email address is mandatory. Optionally, the full name can also be entered. For data publication, membership of an organisation of your choice is required. Mandatory metadata according to the DataCite Metadata Schema³ for DOI allocation as well as optional metadata describing the datasets are collected as part of the data publication. These are available under the open licence CC0 1.0 Universal. Your account data will be stored for the duration of your use of the Research Data Repository. If you no longer wish to use the repository, we will delete your user account upon request. The published datasets, the associated metadata and the licence agreement on which the data publication is based will continue to be stored at TIB. Your data will not be transferred to institutions outside the TIB. The only exception to this is the metadata based on the DataCite Metadata Schema, which is recorded in the course of DOI allocation and transmitted to DataCite.

Your rights⁴:

You have the right to obtain information about the data stored in this library, as well as to request the correction or deletion or restriction of processing or - insofar as the processing is based on your consent - a right of revocation or objection, if applicable, and the right to data portability. Complaints can be made to the above-mentioned supervisory authority. The revocation has no effects on the lawfulness of the processing of the data up to the time of the revocation.
